

**OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**1. KEY DATES:**

The Win with TaylorMade Contest (the “**Contest**”) begins on March 9, 2026 at 12:00 a.m. Eastern Time (“**ET**”) and ends on August 30, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. ET (the “**Contest Period**”).

The Contest Period will consist of forty-four (44) entry periods (each, an “**Entry Period**”), as outlined in the following table. Each Entry Period corresponds with an official 2026 season PGA Tour or LPGA Tour tournament during the Contest Period, as also outlined in the following table (each, a “**Tour Tournament**”).

## 2. ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER:

The Contest is open only to residents of Canada (excluding Quebec) who have reached the legal age of majority in their province/territory of residence at the time of entry, except employees, representatives and agents (and those with whom such persons are living, whether related or not) of Z Line Consulting Inc. (the “**Sponsor**” or “**Golf Talk Canada**”), Taylor Made Golf Canada Ltd. You may only use one (1) X account, one (1) Instagram account and one (1) YouTube account as applicable (each, an “**Account**” and collectively the “**Accounts**”) to participate in this Contest. To be eligible to earn an Entry (each, an “**Entry**” and collectively, the “**Entries**”) in this Contest, your applicable Account must be set to allow your Entry to be viewed by and receive direct messages from the Sponsor.

For greater certainty and the avoidance of any doubt, each Prize consists of one (1) of the above items only (a Prize shall not consist of all items listed in (a)-(i) above).

The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible Tour Tournaments played by Eligible Players during the Contest Period, the number of eligible Entries submitted and received in accordance with these Rules prior to the close of an applicable Entry Period and the performance of Eligible Players during the corresponding Tour Tournaments (as determined by the Sponsor at its sole discretion).

For certainty, in the event that a scheduled Tour Tournament is cancelled for any reason or no Eligible Player completes and wins a Tour Tournament for any reason (including, without limitation, due to health risks or any governmental or health authority orders, measures, directives or guidance in response to such illness or risks, such as those that may be implemented to mitigate COVID-19 transmission, or due to injury, illness or any other cause of any kind or nature whatsoever), no corresponding Prize will be drawn or awarded. In the event that a scheduled Tour Tournament is postponed, re-scheduled or otherwise cannot be completed as originally contemplated as at the start of the Contest Period for any reason (including, without limitation, the reasons set out above), the Sponsor reserves the right, at Sponsor's option and in its sole and absolute discretion, to either modify an Entry Period to accommodate such Tour Tournament or not to conduct a draw for or award any Prize corresponding with such Tour Tournament. The Released Parties shall be released of all liability with respect to any such changes to these Rules and Prizes in connection with any Tour Tournament that is re-scheduled, postponed, cancelled or cannot be completed as originally contemplated at the start of the Contest Period, as set out above.

#### **11. ELIGIBLE WINNER NOTIFICATION PROCESS:**

The Sponsor or its designated representative will make a minimum of two (2) attempts to contact the potential winners within five (5) business days of the applicable Draw Date via Social Platform direct message (based on the applicable Social Platform used for the potential winner's Entry). A potential winner is solely responsible for ensuring they are able to receive such notification messages, monitoring for such notification messages and following all instructions contained in such notification messages, failing which, they may be disqualified (as determined by the Sponsor at its sole discretion).

#### **12. ELIGIBLE WINNER CONFIRMATION PROCESS:**

NO ONE IS A WINNER UNLESS AND UNTIL THE SPONSOR OFFICIALLY CONFIRMS THEM AS A WINNER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THESE RULES. ANYONE DEEMED BY THE SPONSOR TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THE SPONSOR'S INTERPRETATION OF THE LETTER AND/OR SPIRIT OF THESE RULES FOR ANY REASON IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION IN THE SOLE AND ABSOLUTE DISCRETION OF THE SPONSOR AT ANY TIME.

All Contest-Related Information becomes the property of the Sponsor.
